

Tonga's Second Nationally Determined Contribution (NDC) to the Paris Agreement

Energy Sector

≥ 13% (16 Gg) reduction in greenhouse gas emissions (GHG) from energy by 2030 compared to 2006

- 70% of electricity generated from renewable sources
- Mandatory vehicle standards and/or incentives through tax, fees and import tariffs
- Adoption of minimum energy performance standards





Agriculture, Forestry and Other Land Use Sector

- Identification of a GHG emission target for Tonga's Third NDC in 2025
 - Establishment of a forest inventory
- **Planting 1 million trees by 2023**

Waste Sector

Expansion of the formal waste collection system





- **№** 30% of land in Tonga utilized for agro-forestry or forestry by 2025
 - Planting 1 million trees by 2023
- Prevent any permanent loss of land due to rising sea levels
- Maintenance of the existing stocks of fish and other marine species
 - Expansion of Marine Protected Areas (MPAs) and Special Management Areas (SMAs) to 30% of Tonga's Economic Exclusive Zone (EEZ)
